



A Doll's House

by Henrik Ibsen · Best for B1–B2 (Intermediate–Upper intermediate)

Read-along audiobook · B1–B2

Written as a play, this story unfolds almost entirely in conversation, which makes it excellent reading practice. Nora and her husband speak in short, realistic exchanges that feel close to natural speech, yet carry enormous emotional weight. Because you follow a small number of characters across just three acts, the vocabulary stays controlled while the tension builds steadily to its famous final scene.

What you'll practise

- Reported speech and indirect questions in domestic dialogue
- Conditional sentences expressing doubt, threat, and hope
- Stage directions as concise descriptive English
- Read along as each line of dialogue is highlighted aloud
