These are the original German folk tales collected by the Brothers Grimm — Cinderella, Hansel and Gretel, Snow White, and dozens more. Each story is short and self-contained, so you never need to hold a complicated plot in your head. The language is plain and repetitive in the best way: the same patterns come back tale after tale, which is excellent for building your first vocabulary.

What you'll practise

- Simple past narration — 'she walked', 'he said', 'they found'
- Numbers and sequences — once, twice, the third time
- Common household and nature words — forest, bread, mirror, well
- Tap any old word or phrase to see a plain English definition

How to read it — free

Listen to the full narration while you read along — every word above your level is highlighted in time with the voice and explained on tap. No signup, nothing to install.
