Austen's novel follows Elizabeth Bennet and her four sisters as their mother tries to marry them all off to wealthy men. The real pleasure is in the witty dialogue — characters say one thing and mean another, and misunderstandings drive the whole plot. At B1 you will follow the story comfortably; the longer narrative passages are the trickier parts, but the dialogue rewards careful reading.

What you'll practise

- Reported speech and indirect statement in drawing-room conversation
- Vocabulary of social class, manners, and domestic life in Regency England
- Recognising irony when characters are polite but critical
- Read along as each line is highlighted to catch the rhythm of the dialogue
