



# The Metamorphosis

by Franz Kafka · Best for B1–B2 (Intermediate–Upper intermediate)

Read-along audiobook · B1–B2

Gregor Samsa wakes one morning to find he has turned into a large insect, and the rest of the novella follows his family's slow, painful adjustment to this fact. Kafka's prose in translation is unusually clear and domestic — much of the language describes ordinary household objects, family meals, and everyday routines, which makes the growing horror feel all the more real. The short length means you can read it in a single sitting.

## What you'll practise

- Household and domestic vocabulary (furniture, doors, windows, meals)
- Gradual tense shifts as the family's attitude changes over weeks
- Indirect thought and free indirect style to show characters' inner feelings
- Tap any term you are unsure of to see a plain-English definition
