Dorothy is swept away from Kansas by a tornado and lands in a magical country full of talking creatures and surprising quests. Baum's sentences are short and direct, the vocabulary is mostly everyday, and the same core words appear again and again throughout the story. Because the plot is so well known in many cultures, you can follow even when a word is unfamiliar.

## What you'll practise

- Past simple storytelling — 'she walked', 'they said', 'it happened'
- Simple adjectives and comparisons to describe people and places
- Everyday dialogue and polite request forms
- Read along as each word is highlighted so you can connect the spoken sound to the spelling
